225 Anniversary of birth of St Jeanne Jugan

On Wednesday last the Little Sisters of the Poor marked the 225th Anniversary of the birth of their foundress St Jeanne Jugan with a beautiful Solemn Mass. Dom Richard Purcell OCSO, the newly elected Abbot of Mount Melleray Abbey was the main celebrant with 15 priests concelebrating. The Little Sisters were joined by fellow Religious, Residents, Volunteers and Staff and members of the Association of St Jeanne Jugan in celebrating the occasion with hospitality for all afterwards - which of course the Little Sisters take as a fourth vow (Hospitality) in addition to their other vows. The presence of so many shows the high esteem in which the Little Sisters are held since their arrival in Waterford in 1868. Since then they have cared for countless elderly people in their home originally Manor Hill and now in Ferrybank. A specially composed prayer for their houses all over the world consecrating their houses to the Immaculate Heart of Mary was recited by all present for the occasion - as the whole Congregation was united in prayer on this special day. We congratulate them as they continue their public witness as Religious and great work began by their Foundress St Jeanne Jugan.
