In 2017 the hospital had 37,517 emergency attendances, 19,366 day cases, 10,313 in patient admissions, 78,697 outpatient attendances and 13,835 surgical procedures performed.

150th Anniversary of The Little Sisters of the Poor in Waterford.

The Little Sisters of the Poor arrived in Waterford from their Mother House from La Tour St Joseph in Brittany France in 1868. They first rented a home at 3 Adelphi Terrace in Waterford City where they set up their first care home for the elderly in Waterford City.

In 1874 they built their first purpose built home at Manor Hill Waterford where they cared for the elderly in a very caring and loving atmosphere until they moved to St Joseph's Home in Ferrybank in 2010. In 1993 they celebrated 125 years in Waterford and were presented with a plaque of thanksgiving from the Mayor of Waterford at the time Clr. Tom Brown in which he thanked The Little Sisters on behalf of the people of Waterford for their dedicated services. On Saturday 14th ...

April the Little Sisters celebrated their 150th Anniversary in Waterford by a Thanksgiving Mass concelebrated by Bishop Dermot Farrell and many priests after which they celebrated with their Mother Provincial, Mother Kathleen, Sisters, residents, volunteers, and benefactors.
