A few Thoughts from Fr. Kieran

This weekend our readings focus on the role of the prophet. It is important to remember that a prophet is not one who foretells the future but one who is conscious of their calling & their vocation to proclaim the Word of God. We are familiar with the prophets of the Old Testament like Jeremiah who we meet this weekend but their have been many more too down through the generations who have boldly spoken and witnessed to the love of God, many giving their lives. Being a prophet is not an easy calling, only God gives the strength to persevere even in the midst of rejection. The prophets greatest tool is Love, that same love which Paul talks about. It is this Love when accepted that transforms lives and softens hearts. Jesus the Son of God is the prophet par excellence. In his life, death and resurrection a model is provided for all who witness to the Love of God in our Church and the world. So what about you and me? In fact all of us are called to be prophets by virtue of our baptism, to witness to the Love of God, by the way we live our lives to witness to the truth and the truth is Jesus Christ. It never was easy to be a prophet, it never will be, but that is our calling and God is with us, after all..
